ST MARY DE CASTRO CHURCH, LEICESTER BAPTISM REGISTER AND SURNAME INDEX

St Mary de Castro baptism register has been recorded and indexed from 1600 to 1921 – a total of 321 years and 29,191 baptisms. It does not seem to be included in the International Genealogical Index (IGI) after 1836. (It appears to be included in the IGI prior to 1837 under the names of St Mary and St Mary de Castro). Parts of this register in the 1700s are difficult to read.


ST GEORGE'S CHURCH, LEICESTER BAPTISM REGISTER AND SURNAME INDEX

St George's baptism register has been recorded and indexed from 1827 to 1921 – a total of 94 years and 14,244 baptisms. It does not seem to be included in the International Genealogical Index (IGI) after 1875. Although this is not an 'ancient' church it has been included to complete the pre1837 Anglican baptisms in Leicester Borough.

This CD contains the names of children or adults baptised, their parents (if given) and surname, plus date, year, microfiche reference and register number (if any). It is not a transcription, does not include any birth dates (if given), or additional information such as occupation, army regiment or abode etc. The original registers should be consulted for confirmation of details. They can be seen at the Leicester, Leics and Rutland Records Office and also viewed on microfiche there. The Leics & Rutland Family History Society have acquired most of the microfiche.

The register numbers quoted are as in the registers – however, the early books before 1813 do not contain register numbers. Each book after 1812 starts at '1' and so consequently the register numbers will be repeated. Not all entries were recorded by the incumbent in chronological order.
